ALL INTACT MALES MUST BE REGISTERED

1. All intact males must be registered. Breed entries must be registered with Breed Association. Definitions: ACTCP 160.08 (2) and ATCP 160.09 (1). Cattle may not be shown in the Open Show.
2. **ALL YOUTH EXHIBITORS ARE REQUIRED TO ATTEND THREE (3) CLINICS TO BE ELIGIBLE TO SHOW AT THE JACKSON COUNTY FAIR. THE BEEF SAFETY WORKSHOP IS REQUIRED FOR YOU SHOWING BEEF FOR THE FIRST TIME. YQCA IS REQUIRED FOR ALL YOUTH.**
3. Animals must be checked-in and weighed-in between 9 a.m. – 12 p.m. on Wednesday. Market Beef ultrasound will follow Swine weigh-in ultrasound.
4. Sheep have priority to the wash racks on Wednesday until 4 p.m.

MARKET CLASSES

REGULATIONS:

1. All Jr. Division beef, dairy and dairy beef cross steers & heifers will be entered in this class. Steers & heifers may be divided into weight classes.
2. Each exhibitor may exhibit 3 steers or heifers
3. Exhibitors may exhibit only 1 animal per weight class except 2 are allowed in the heaviest class (steers & heifers may be moved up to the next heavier weight class).
4. All steers & heifers must be born on or after January 1st of the previous year.
5. No horns will be allowed on a market animal.
6. Mouthing of steers & heifers for age may be done at the fair.
7. Animals uncontrollable by the exhibitor may be removed by Superintendent.
8. Minimum weight of steers & heifers is 1,076 pounds. (Holstein & Brown Swiss 1,200 pounds) to be eligible to sell.
9. Animals not meeting weight requirements will not be eligible to receive special awards.
10. No color changing of animals.

LIVESTOCK TOTAL PERFORMANCE AWARD – JUNIOR FAIR

This award will be present to the exhibitor whose animal best performs in all phases of livestock competition at the Jackson County Fair. Recognition will be based upon live show placing, ranking in the carcass show. Evaluation procedures to determine the total performance award for each species of livestock will be based upon the lowest combination for ranking scores from the three areas of competition. Live ranking will designate Grand and Reserve Champion as first and second respectively followed by the class standing positions, blue group through pink group. Carcass rankings are determined by numerical placings.
