1. **ALL INTACT MALES MUST BE REGISTERED**
2. No swine can be unloaded at the fair until health papers have been checked by a fair official. Breed entries must be registered with Breed Association. Health Regulations Definitions: See "WI Administrative Code Chapter 5.
3. Animals may not be shown in open show.
4. Animals must be checked-in by 12 p.m. and weigh-in starts at 12 p.m. on Wednesday.
5. Sheep have priority to the wash racks on Wednesday until 4 p.m.

All youth exhibitors are required to attend three (3) clinics to be eligible to show at the Jackson County Fair. YQCA is required for all youth that have not tested out of the requirement.

MARKET CLASSES (Any Breed or Crossbred, Barrow or Gilt) REGULATIONS:

1. Market hogs may be divided into weight classes if numbers permit (sub divisions of the weight classes may be added for judging purposes)
2. Minimum weight of a market pig shall be 236 pounds.
3. Each exhibitor may exhibit 3 hogs
4. Exhibitors may exhibit only one hog per class except 2 may be allowed in the heavy class
5. Market hogs may be moved up to a heavier weight class
6. Animals not meeting weight requirements will not be eligible to receive special awards
7. A gilt show as a market hog can not be shown as a breeding gilt
8. All pigs shown will be shipped for slaughter. This is a terminal show.

Exhibitor may enter a market hog shown at the current fair (one entry per exhibitor). I.D. number of animal to be entered into the carcass contest must be declared at the final weigh-in and ultrasounded at that time. *Animal must have final weight taken at fair final weigh in.

LIVESTOCK TOTAL PERFORMANCE AWARD – JUNIOR FAIR

This award will be present to the exhibitor whose animal best performs in all phases of livestock competition at the Jackson County Fair. Recognition will be based upon live show placing, ranking in the carcass show. Evaluation procedures to determine the total performance award for each species of livestock will be based upon the lowest combination for ranking scores from the three areas of competition. Live ranking will designate Grand and Reserve Champion as first and second respectively followed by the class standing positions, blue group through pink group. Carcass rankings are determined by numerical placings.
