**REGULATIONS:**

1. All goats exhibited here must have a scrapie premise identification tag or tattoo.
2. No animals will be permitted to unload without the tag and checked in by the superintendent.
3. Animal ID check information (please see website) and health certificate need to be together at check in.
4. Only animals entered into a class maybe unloaded and placed in a pen (no companion animals).
5. Animals eligible to show any other department will not be allowed to exhibit here.
6. Exhibitors may not enter more than one animal in each item number.
7. All animal's ages shall be as of FAIR DATE of the current year.
8. Goats with full natural horns may not be entered unless full natural horns are a standard for specific breed.
9. Each exhibitor shall provide their own feed and bedding and will be responsible for their own animal(s).
10. Exhibitors are required to keep their areas neat, clean and to sign up for barn duty.
11. In order to show at the fair, youth registered in the goat project must participate in YQCA, attend 1 small animal or livestock meeting, and attend 2 workshops either livestock and/or small animal.
12. Goats with warts, abscesses, ringworm, mange or any other contagious diseases will not be permitted to be exhibited. Any animal found to be infected will be removed immediately from the premises.
13. No dairy goat does over the age of 2 which have never freshened may be exhibited.
14. All goat exhibitors must wear the appropriate show attire for their type of goat shown. All Meat and Market goat exhibitors must wear a button front shirt with collar and sleeves, appropriate long pants and shoes must be of the hard sole type (no tennis shoes, caps or hats). Market exhibitors will have exhibitor numbers that must be displayed. All other goat exhibitors are to wear all white. Shirts should once again be buttoned up the front with sleeves and collars.
15. Scurs (horns) may only be 1 inch or less. No open sinus cavities where horns were removed will be allowed. The area must be healed and covered with skin.
16. Overall showperson will be chosen.
17. Market animals must be checked-in and weighed-in between 9 a.m. – 11 a.m. on Wednesday or may be brought in Tuesday night at the liability of the exhibitor. All others (dairy, breeding classes have until 1 p.m. on Wednesday.
18. Sheep have priority to the wash racks on Wednesday until 4 p.m.

### CLASS I – MARKET MEAT WETHER/DOE

#### REGULATIONS:

1. Meat wether/does need to be weighed at the spring weigh-in and also again at the fair. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to get their market goat to the weigh-ins or they cannot show.
2. No sexually intact males allowed.
3. All market goats must weigh in a minimum of 50 lbs. to make sale at fair check in.
4. All market goats will be born after December 1 of previous year.
5. All market goat exhibitors must complete and present YQCA form. No exceptions
6. All market goats must be de-horned.
7. No medicated animals will be allowed.
8. Exhibitors may exhibit only one animal per weight class, except two in the heaviest weight class.
9. Market goats may be divided into 3 weight classes if numbers permit.
10. Each exhibitor must participate in the showmanship class to be eligible for sale. Use age as of January 1<sup>st</sup> of show year. Must use own Junior Fair exhibit animal.
