**DEFINITION:** Cockerels and pullets are birds hatched on or after January 1 of exhibit year. Chickens over 4 months of age will be pullorum tested. They need to be tested before the opening day of the fair. Rene Rommel is a licensed pullorum tester. His phone number is 715-299-0377. All Poultry and Rabbit meat classes must be judged by noon. All champions sell. Must be notify superintendent if any alternative is needed from another class (ex: beef, sheep, swine)

#### REGULATIONS:

1. Exhibitor must be present when poultry is judged.
2. Poultry must be checked-in by 10:30 a.m. on Thursday.
3. Animals will be brought to the fair in humane cages.
4. Meat Market animals will be weighed at check in time with exhibitor or parent present. Birds not making weight will be disqualified and sent home.
5. No premium will be paid on disqualified birds or birds lacking merit.
6. No exhibitor is allowed more than 1 entry in an item number.
7. Feed will NOT be provided; exhibitors are responsible for feeding, watering, and cleaning their own pens every day. Failure to do so will result in disqualification.
8. All birds will be inspected by the Superintendent upon check in. Birds shall be checked in by 10:30 on entry day. Unhealthy birds will be sent home.
9. Showmanship will be judged last.
10. Overall Showperson will be chosen with the help of the judge.
11. Outstanding awards will be given at the judges discretion.
12. Each club with poultry entries will be responsible for Barn Duty. Barn Duty sign-up sheet will be posted.
13. Any turkeys over 6 months of age are NOT allowed at the fair.
14. Must participate in 3 small animal events – 1 meeting, 1 workshop, & 1 auction plus YQCA.
15. Mature birds need to be pullorum tested, young birds hatched from your stock need flock test papers, and meat birds need hatchery certificate.
16. Animal I.D. check information (please find at [jacksoncountyfairwi.com](http://jacksoncountyfairwi.com)) and pullorum flock test paper or hatchery certificate need to be together at check-in.
17. Market animals will be judged first.
18. Best of Show and Reserve Best of Show.
