REGULATIONS:

3. Exhibitors may not enter more than one animal in each item number
4. Entrants must be a member of a recognized youth group of Jackson County.
5. To show at the fair, youth registered in any of the small animal projects – including pets – must participate in 3 small animal events: 1 meeting, 1 workshop, and 1 auction.
