2. All sheep exhibited must be identified with official scrapie ear tags or other scrapie identification.
3. Sheep exposed to scrapie will not be allowed for exhibition. See pg. 12 for health requirements.
4. Sheep have priority to the wash racks on Wednesday until 4 p.m.
5. Animals must be checked-in and weighed-in between 9 a.m. – 1 p.m. on Wednesday or may be brought in on Tuesday night at the liability of the exhibitor.

**REGULATIONS:**

Registered wool breeds including Columbias, Corriedales, Rambouillets and Targhees shall be shown with 1 inch of wool or more. All meat breeds shall be shown with 1 inch of wool or less.

3. Minimum weight for market lambs shall be 110 pounds.
