REGULATIONS:

1. Exhibitors should bring a suitable container for each cut flower exhibit and other exhibits.
2. In all classes the flowers should have adequate stem length.
3. Flowers must be in bloom.
4. Superintendent has the privilege of rejecting any flower or plant not meeting requirements.
5. Items in dried arrangements must be new each year. Items will be marked.
6. Pot plants in pots no larger than 8".
7. Hanging baskets in baskets no larger than 14" diameter.
8. For large containers, confirm display area with superintendent.
9. For arrangements, recommended to use foam oasis base in vase for stability.

23. Snapdragons, any colors – 3 stems.

25. Zinnia, dwarf, any color – 3 blooms.
26. Zinnia, giant, any color – 3 blooms.
27. Zinnia, cactus – 3 stems.
28. Sun flowers, giant – 1 stem.

30. Any other annual flower, not listed above.
