- Any antiques approximately 50 years old or older.
- Antique items previously exhibited at the Jackson County fair and receiving a premium are not eligible for entry.
- Items will be disqualified if entered in the wrong category.
- Please have all items tagged and stubs removed prior to entry.
- Only one article will be accepted for each item, at the superintendent's discretion (Exceptions: original sets and cookie cutters)
- Judging will be on Friday of the Fair, at 8:30am
- All exhibits must be picked up between 4:30 and 6:00pm on the last day of the Fair. Please bring tag stubs to aid in claiming items.
- No item or article will be insured by the fair association for theft or breakage.
- No weapons, please
- The Superintendent has the privilege of rejecting any item not meeting the requirements.
- Entries from exhibitors residing outside of Jackson County will be allowed based on space available.
