Each exhibitor will be able to exhibit a maximum of 5 items. Exhibitors may show only one project per item number. It will not be necessary to check your exhibits in prior to judging. 1. Bottle camp doormat
 2. Any woodworking item
 3. A simple art or craft article you have made
 4. A leather article made by you
 5. A creature you have created
 6. A macrame article made by you
 7. A small terrarium you have made
 8. Potted houseplant you have started from cutting
 9. Four kinds of labeled plants growing in same pot you have started from seed.
 10. A plate of vegetables you have grown, selected from "garden list"
 11. A garden box exhibit of four vegetables you have grown (for required specimen numbers use exhibit box of garden products list)
 12. A garden flower display of flowers you have grown
 13. A poster 14"x11" of four labeled pictures or drawings of wildflowers that are protected by Wisconsin Law.
 14. Two photographs showing beauty of nature, tell which objects make it beautiful
 15. A scrapbook you have made about birds
 16. A poster 14"x11" of five tree leaves mounted and properly labeled
 17. A booklet you have made on weather
 18. Six insects in a box mounted and properly labeled
 19. A group of five pictures you have taken
 20. A record of a trip you took
 21. A home safety poster, 14"x11" you made
 22. A poster 14"x11" you have made on your favorite sport
 23. A poster 14"x11" you have made about you

CLASS B – CLOVERBUDS (AN INTRODUCTION TO 4-H)

Open to members enrolled as "CLOVERBUDS" (grades K-2 as of September 1 of fair year). All Cloverbud exhibits will be judged face-to-face starting on Thursday. Judges will be older Junior Youth. Judging times will be assigned. Cloverbuds should bring their items with them at their judging time. Items will be displayed immediately after judging, except for food. Cloverbuds will receive ribbons for their exhibits, but no premiums will be given. **NO ANIMALS MAY BE EXHIBITED.** Each Cloverbud member may exhibit up to 3 articles from the items listed below. **Cloverbuds are NOT required to pay the \$7 entry fee.** Please see the general fair rules on our website at www.jacksoncountyfairwi.com

1. Something you have made
2. Any craft item you have made
3. A poster you have made (11"x14")
4. Something you have baked
5. Something you have grown
6. Something you have sewn
7. A picture you have made (no larger than 11"x14")
8. Collection of items (insects, leaves, etc.)
9. 5 completed activities from your Cloverbud Activity Book
10. A photography you took
11. Any other item not listed above – excluding animals.
