2023 Jackson County Dairy All Breeds Futurity

The Jackson County Dairy Committee encourages you to make your entries for the 2023 Futurity. This will be a class of two-year old cows consisting of all breeds.

DEADLINE FOR THE 2023 FUTURITY WILL BE DECEMBER 31, 2021.

PURPOSE:

To promote an interest in breeding and exhibiting registered dairy cattle, while encouraging additional participation in dairy entries at the Jackson County Fair.

PROCEDURES:

An animal will be nominated by their owner. The dates, fees, and rules of the futurity will be followed, and there will be no exceptions to any deadline or rule. The Jackson County Dairy Committee is in charge of enforcing all rules regarding the operation of the Futurity.

ENTRANTS:

1. Entrants must wear normal show attire or attire suitable for a futurity. No blue jeans.
2. Entrants may show their animals in either the open show or junior dairy cattle show provided they meet the requirements set forth in their respective fairbooks and have been properly entered.

FEES:

Entries, along with \$20 per animals must be postmarked by December 31, 2021.

NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED!

REFUNDS:

When entry fees and any payment in connection with the futurity are received, they are committed for the purse of this event and no refunds will be made.

PURSE:

The purse will consist of all monies (entry fees and sponsorships) received by the Dairy Committee, less actual expenses, which will be divided as prize money among participating exhibitors only. Everyone who shows gets their entry fee back (\$20). Payout additional money to Top 3. 1st – 50% of remaining pot and entry fee • 2nd – 35% of remaining pot and entry fee • 3rd – 15% of remaining pot and entry fee

ELIGIBILITY:

1. The Animals must be owned by a Jackson County resident. If an animal entered in the Jackson County Futurity is sold, eligibility may be transferred to the new owner, and it is his/her responsibility to inform the Dairy Committee of the change in ownership prior to the show.
2. Any animals that is 87% RHA or higher with official Breed Association papers. All colored breed animals must have PR (Provisional Registration) papers.
3. All matters pertaining to the showing of the Futurity are subject to the rules, regulations, and health requirements of the Jackson County Fair.
4. Any animals born between September 1, 2020 and August 31 of 2021 will be eligible for the entry in the 2023 Jackson County Fair.
5. All animals and owners must meet the requirements set forth by the Jackson County Fair Book Rules.
6. Futurity animals may be owned by a person of any age, however, entries must be led by someone who is at least 10 years of age. Age will be determined by the date of the show.
