REGULATIONS:

1. Each clothing exhibitor is allowed a maximum of eight (8) entries.
2. Clothing Revue exhibits may be entered for fair judging in Class A, B, C, or D.
3. Exhibitors must provide suitable hangers for garments so they can be hung for exhibit.
4. Exhibitors tags should be fastened securely to garment.
5. Each exhibit must have a 3"x5" card attached with the following information.
 - a. Fiber Content – List percentage
 - b. Intended care
 - c. Intended use
 - d. Type of interfacing used, if interfacing is necessary

If card is not attached to exhibit, the premium will be lowered on place

6. Purchased ensemble (one or more pieces): accessories are a part of ensemble. On a 3"x5" card, list: cost, care, construction comments: state how garment fits into wardrobe, how you will accessorize this ensemble and why you chose this particular ensemble (colors, design, patter).
7. All exhibits that have been worn, must be freshly laundered when exhibited.
8. Definition:
 - a. Recycled – article of clothing made into a different clothing item.
 - b. Upcycled – purchased or sewn item of clothing with added embellishments or adapted for special purpose.
 - c. For both Recycled and Upcycled items must include a 3"x5" card describing changes and a before and during photo demonstrating the changes.
9. All entries are to be entered by 10:30a.m. on entry day.
10. The Superintendent has the privilege of rejecting an item not meeting the requirements.
11. Exhibits not meeting criteria will be lowered one premium.
