**REGULATIONS:**

1. All exhibits must be in place by 10:30a.m. on entry day or exhibits will be disqualified.
2. Open to members enrolled in Home Environment Project and other groups doing equivalent work.
3. Exhibitor can enter in only ONE CLASS
4. **All items entered in Class A will be judged face-to-face and should be brought to the judge by the exhibitor and/or adult for evaluation. If they do not attend face-to-face, they will be lowered one placing, if unable to attend let superintendent know or make other arrangements. Exhibitors may exhibit a maximum of 4 items.**
5. **In all Classes include a card with a description of room or area where the item will be used. (Room colors special decorating items) and describe how the item will complement the room. Describe what you did to create the exhibit. If explanation is not attached, premiums will be lowered one place.**
6. All exhibit items must be made, finished, or refinished by the exhibitor, unless otherwise specified.
7. A suitable hanger should be attached to all items intended for hanging.
8. All items must be clean.
9. Articles can be covered with plastic wrap to prevent soiling at the Fair.
10. Silk flowers to be entered under artificial material
11. Definition: Natural plant material is any material of natural origin, may be purchased.
12. Definition: Original is own design and chooses colors, yarns. A kit or non-original piece is when fabric, yarns, patterns are supplied, and/or suggested. This definition describes all kit items listed in this department.
13. Definition: Decoupage articles – pictures glued to board, then completed by sanding & finishing several times.
14. No Macrame or ceramic work can be exhibited in the Home Furnishing Department. Exhibit these items in the Cultural Arts Department.
15. Exhibit MAY NOT enter identical items or articles in any corresponding regular junior division.
16. **No more than eight (8) entries will be accepted in Class B and C.**
17. The Superintendent has the privilege of rejecting any item not meeting the requirements.
