REGULATIONS:

1. All exhibits must be in place by 10:30a.m. on entry day, or exhibits will be disqualified.
2. All exhibits are to be made by exhibitor, unless otherwise specified.
3. **In (*) starred classes a short explanation giving age and sex of the child and the child's reaction to item must accompany the exhibit. If the explanation is not attached, the premium will be lowered once place. Include statement why you chose to make the item.**
4. Descriptions:
Four areas of Growth: Physical, Mental, Social, Emotional
Picture Story Book: 4-H member can draw or select pictures. Pictures to be in sequence letting the events tell a story, or each picture tells a story by itself.
Picture Dictionary: 4-H member selects pictures to identify A, B, C's
My Quiet Book: A book for a pre-schooler to help develop finger and eye coordinations and to recognize colors and shapes.
Dictated Story Book: Ask a child to tell you a story. Take down the exact words and find pictures to complete the story.
5. Not more than eight (8) entries will be accepted from any exhibitor.
6. All poster sizes are 14"x22"
7. The Superintendent has the privilege of rejecting any item not meeting the requirements.

Item

1. A display representing important events that have influenced my life
2. Poster with snapshots or pictures showing the four (4) areas of growth of a child. (Pictures must be of same child)
3. * A child's puppet with a script that teaches one of the following: Safety; Color, Shapes; Nutrition; Eating Habits; Emotions; What to do if you get lost; numbers
4. * Picture story book: tell reason for purchasing and why you think the book is suitable for a particular preschooler or school age child
5. * Picture story book: tell reason for making and why you think the book is suitable for a particular preschooler or school aged child
6. * Picture dictionary: tell reason for purchasing and why you think the book is suitable for a particular preschooler or school aged child
7. * Picture dictionary: tell reason for making and why you think the book is suitable for a particular preschooler or school aged child
8. * My Quiet Book: tell reason for purchasing and why you think the book is suitable for a particular preschooler or school aged child
9. * My Quiet Book: tell reason for making and why you think the book is suitable for a particular preschooler or school aged child
10. * Toy made for a child state age of child and tell how the toy was made
11. * Game for a preschool child or school aged child: state age of child, reason for making, how it was made, and playing instructions

Item

1. Poster with snapshots or pictures showing the four (4) areas of growth of a child
2. A child's puppet with a script that teaches one of the following: Friendship; honesty; love; justice or any other personal value
3. * Picture Story Book: tell reason for making and why you think the book is suitable for a particular child of school age or preschooler
4. * Picture Dictionary: tell reason for making and why you think the book is suitable for a particular child of school age or preschooler
5. * Dictated Story Book: Tell reason for making and why you think the book is suitable for a particular child of school age or preschooler
6. * Toy made for a child other than wood, state age of child and tell how the toy was made
7. * Toy made of wood, state age of child for whom toy was made fore
8. * A game for a school age child or preschooler: state age of child, reason for making, how it was made, and playing instructions.
9. Play apron – include explanation of how apron will be used and if it will be worn by child or adult
10. Safety poster or exhibit – poster 14"x22"
11. Poster or exhibit dealing with drugs; alcohol; child abuse; etc. – poster 14"x22"
12. Babysitting kit, must be displayed with carrying case (include age of child kit is designed for)

Item

1. Make a Family Group genealogy record of your family
2. Make an oral Family history, audio cassette
3. Make an oral Family history, script
4. Select and mount a Family photo (11"x14") or make a photo display of your family
5. Make a Family banner (paper or cloth) 3'x4'
6. Make a Family scrapbook (pictures and mementos showing various things or traits family members have in common.)
7. List Family familiar songs (use the who, what, when, where, and why the songs are favorites)
8. List Family favorite games (use the who, what, when, where, and why the games are favorites)
9. Around the central theme, develop a Family celebration. Display items you would select such as invitations, music, quotes, prayers
10. Create 15 Coupons ready to give the Family and Friends
11. Any other related exhibit

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CLASS D – HISTORY AND HERITAGE – OPEN TO ALL MEMBERS

Item

1. A mini display in Heritage box (ecology box) which illustrates some aspect of your family's history
2. A collection of "old" family recipes and information about the origin
3. A family tree in pictures – Mounted on poster 14"x22"
4. A family album you have developed which tells the story of your family in words and pictures
5. A photo timeline of your life (poster 14"x22"). A photo of yourself from each year of your life, mounted. Along with picture, includes anecdotes, drawings, and comments
6. A book showing timeline of your life. A photo of yourself from each year of your life, mounted. Along with picture, includes anecdotes, drawings and comments.
7. A display of 4 or more old-fashioned games you can make from household odds and ends. Include a written description of each game and how it originated, if you can find it.
8. A recipe book of old home remedies used for illness
9. A material object (photograph or actual) which expresses a part of your family or community history
10. A creative history of an animal important to you and your family
11. A display of an old-time craft – Whittling, soap making, quilting, using natural dyes, chair caning, etc. Include a description of how to do the craft.
12. Any exhibitor related to "who Am I" (Genealogy guide)
13. Any exhibited related to "How Was It" (the interview guide, Town History Guide, and Community Biography Guide)
14. Any exhibit related to "Where Am I?" (Landmarks Guide, Town History Guide)
15. Any other exhibit related to the history and heritage project
16. Photo story of holiday celebrations and customs (i.e., Halloween costumes, Christmas, etc.)
17. Photo story of traditional architecture (i.e., barns, corn cribs, etc.)
18. Photo story of community events and festivals (i.e., Old Fashion Days, Strawberry Fest, Karner Blue Butterfly Fest)
19. Any other event
